

## **Gretta Waggoner Kistler – NC Zeta Scholarship**

The Gretta Waggoner Kistler-NC Zeta Scholarship is awarded annually by the North Carolina Zeta Chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa. Alpha Delta Kappa is an international sorority of women educators. The Zeta Chapter members are primarily teachers within the Charlotte-Mecklenburg School System. Gretta Waggoner Kistler was a retired teacher and supervisor with the Charlotte-Mecklenburg School System and was the first state president of North Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa.

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The Gretta Waggoner Kistler-NC Zeta Scholarship is open to any female or male student who is currently expected to graduate from one of the accredited high schools in North Carolina, within the region. The graduate should expect to enroll in a four-year college or university in North Carolina next fall and must meet eligibility requirements. This scholarship is a one-year scholarship (non-renewable) in the amount of \$1000.00.

- I. Eligibility requirements for Applicant
  - a. Application submitted to college of choice
  - b. Academic rank in top 10% of senior class
  - c. Minimum SAT score of 900 or ACT composite score of 20
  - d. Good character
  - e. Participation in extra-curricular activities (school and community)
  - f. Financial need (This is not a primary consideration.)
  
- II. Data to be submitted
  - a. Application
  - b. Sealed transcript (including first semester senior grades, SAT and/or ACT scores, cumulative numerical academic average and rank in class)
  - c. Two sealed letters of recommendation. One of the letters must be from one of the applicant's teachers, past or present. The letter should include character traits, special talents and abilities, examples of leadership and service, etc.
  - d. Recent picture (optional)
  - e. Letter from applicant stating his/her plans, career goals, and reasons for wanting the scholarship
  - f. Format for applicant's letter and letters of recommendations:

- III. Procedures for applying
  - a. Student must meet all eligibility requirements
  - b. Submit ALL requested data by deadline of April 20, 2019
  - c. Agree to be available for an interview, if needed and/or requested

- IV. Information related to the scholarship recipient's obligations
- a. The recipient can receive additional scholarships for the time covered by this scholarship, except in the case of a full scholarship. Should a full scholarship be received, the recipient must notify one of the Zeta Chapter Scholarship Chairpersons and must relinquish this scholarship.
  - b. The scholarship recipient must attend a four-year college or university in North Carolina. In the event the recipient decides to attend a college/university outside North Carolina or a two-year college, the recipient will be ineligible for this scholarship.
  - c. If the recipient withdraws from school during the freshman year, the recipient must notify one of the Zeta Scholarship Chairpersons.
