- Have a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of at least 3.0

- Submit two sealed and signed letters of recommendation, one from a teacher or school official and one from a Minister or Community Leader. (No relatives)
- Write a 450-500 word essay (if not met recipient will be disqualified) on one of the two following topics:
  - What does it mean to be a Finer Woman? Describe 3 ways you can demonstrate being a finer woman in your local community that will impact young girls.
  - O How can you use social media to foster a positive female image in today's society?
- Submit an official sealed transcript.
- Submit University/College Acceptance Letter(s)
- Submit application with a current picture (preferably a senior class photo)
