## Sidney Bronson Scholarship General Eligibility Requirement

Applicants for this Scholarship must:

- Must be a graduate of a Charlotte- Mecklenburg School
- Enter an accredited college or university as a freshman, sophomore, junior or senior
- Have accumulative a grade point average GPA of 2.75 or higher from your last school attended.
- Be involved in school and community activities.
- Demonstrate a mastery of written communication skills in in a 300 to 500 word essay

### Application Process

- Complete application and return it to the address below along with a head shot photo (at least a 2x3 and no larger than 5x7 of applicant).
- Application must be accompanied by two current letters of recommendation (written by a school and a community representative.)
- Letters from supervisors and/or copies of certificates of participation from organizations where you performed your community service. (Applicant must have verified volunteer hours, please be specific about your duties.)
- Have the last school you attended submit an official transcript to the address below.
- Application must be accompanied by this essay that adheres to the following standards:
  - Essay must contain 300 to 500 words
  - Essay must be typed and double-spaced
  - Essay must be written on the following topic
